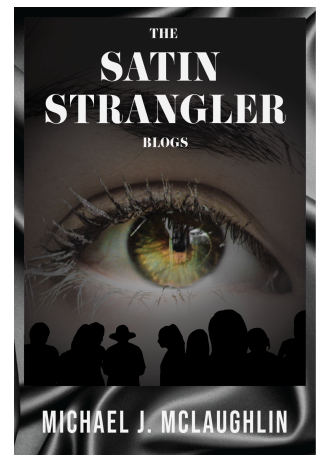
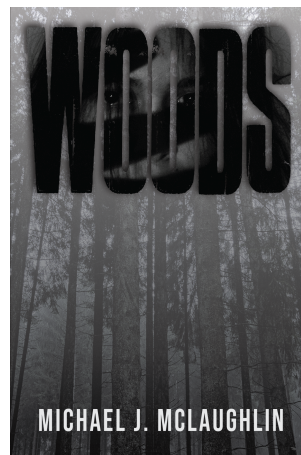
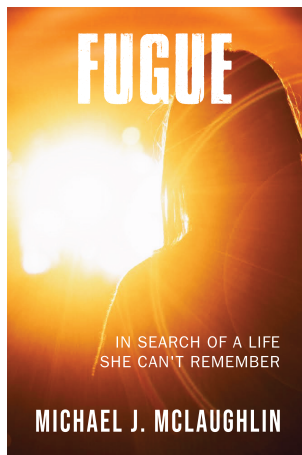
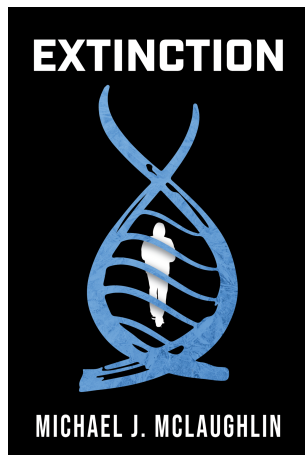
BIOGRAPHY
